Provision and support in school will be implemented and advice and support for home given - working in partnership with parents/carers

If further support is needed then the SENCO will attend the Local Inclusion Information Team (LIFT) meeting for further advice and possible support from the Specialist Teaching and Learning Service (STLS).

Support in school from an outside professional e.g Specialist Teacher, Educational Psychologist, Physiotherapist
Advice and provision implemented in school

If agreed, High Needs Funding will be applied for- this is to support more specialist provision through accessing further funding from the local authority.

Working in partnership with parents and all professionals an Education Health and Care Plan (EHCP) will be applied for - this is a possible access to specialist provision in the future

Throughout this whole process school will work in close partnership with parents/carers and will hold regular meetings and reviews of targets and plans.
