In such cases, we kindly request you to notify the school in advance and provide evidence of the appointment, such as a doctor's note or appointment confirmation. This helps us maintain accurate attendance records and ensures your child's absences are recorded appropriately.

If you have concerns or face unavoidable circumstances that may lead to your child's absence, please do not hesitate to communicate with us. We are here to support you and your child in any way we can.
