RE: National Child Measurement Programme – Reception Year children

Your child is invited to participate in the Reception Year National Child Measurement Programme offered by Kent Community Health NHS Foundation Trust.

National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP)

Each year in England, school children in Reception have their height and weight checked at school as part of the NCMP. Height and weight measurements are used to calculate weight status. We collect this information because it builds a picture of how children are growing and helps plan better health and leisure services for families. This data also allows us to offer your family further support and advice about your child's weight.

The NCMP will be from October 2023 until the end of the academic year.

The checks are completed by trained healthcare professionals. Children are measured fully clothed, except for their coats and shoes, in a private space away from other pupils.

Please be aware that your child will not have to take part on the day if they do not want to or are unable to do so. We will contact you to let you know if this happens. None of their measurements are shared with your child's school or any other agencies. You can also be reassured they will not be discussed with your child.

The results are sent to you, so the decision whether to talk to your child about them is entirely yours. More information is available on Kent Family or in this helpful Guide for Parents

If you **do not** want your child to take part in the NCMP, please tell Kent School Health by **Wednesday 15**th November 2023, using either this link Opt out Form or by calling 0300 123 5205, Option two. You will need to provide us with your child's name, address, date of birth, school name and address so we do not screen your child.
