Zones of Regulation		
My zone	How I feel	I need to...
Red Zone	angry, furious, terrified	stop
Yellow Zone	annoyed, silly, worried, too excited, scared	slow
Green Zone	excited, calm, happy	go
Blue Zone	tired, bored, hurt, sad, upset	rest
