THE SIX PRINCIPLES OF NUTURE



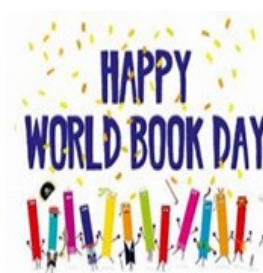
At Cecil Road we create **safe spaces** for our children, this helps them to express how they are feeling.

What you need: two players, three markers and a ball

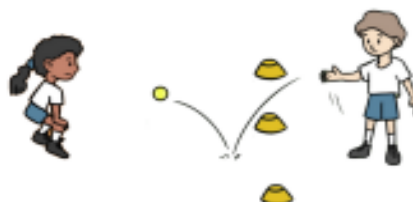


How to play:
