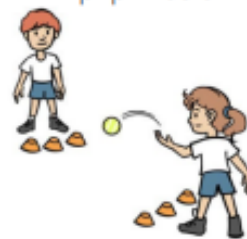
## Hot Spots

- Make this easier by using a bigger ball.
