<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Our Remote Learning Policy lays out in detail what our school will offer in the event of individual isolation, bubble close or full school closure due to Covid. You can access all remote learning for your child via Microsoft Teams. Learning will be provided daily enabling parents to work with children in a timetable that works for them. From time to time, other video teaching inputs may be used from sites such as White Rose Maths, Oaks National Academy and YouTube. As well as presentations by our staff. A daily year group TEAMS meeting will take place to allow all children, both in school and at home to feel connected. Parents and Carers have been provided with a personalised logins, for their child for the 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plan for lessons that would usually happen in the school day. Ensure learning matches the curriculum needs of the pupils. Provide a suitable form of instruction, modelling or scaffolding for each lesson. Supplement lessons with activities, workbooks, textbooks, videos, good quality online resources and other suitable materials to ensure children are continuing their planned learning. Upload daily learning assignments to TEAMS. Assess learning either individually, as a group or whole class level and use this to inform what learning happens next. Contact parents if required to discuss learning. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stay safe online by reading the school's Children Remote Learning document with a parent/carer. Commit to completing all learning set by the class teacher daily. Submit learning for feedback by the teacher via TEAMS or by uploading/ emailing a photo or file. Listen or read carefully to instructions/ explanations given. Ask questions, if unsure how to complete learning via TEAMS post or home learning email. Join the daily Morning Meet wherever possible. Continue to read regularly and engage in 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Support Home Learning by reading Parent Remote Learning Document. Know where to access the school's Remote Learning. Ensure their child completes the expected learning set or communicate timely the reason it has not. Know where and when to submit learning completed and support in this process if needed. Have notified the school of their accessibility to a device so the best provision can be put into place. Ensure their device is secure and they are following school protocols for using the online platform, agreeing to the school's AUPs. Contact the school if their child is struggling to access
