Rotary Club Assembly ShelterBox Appeal Indonesia Earthquake 2018


Last week the Rotary Club of Gravesend visited our school and talked to the children about their ShelterBox Appeal.



A ShelterBox provides: a tent capable of providing shelter for a family of ten, a bag of colouring pencils and paper for the youngest child. An Axe to cut the wood for the stove and "life straws" providing clean drinking water from contaminated puddles. Ground sheets, sleeping bags and mosquito nets were amongst many other items. Everything needed by a family or group of ten people suddenly left without shelter, power or possessions has been thought about and packed into a green ShelterBox.

Following this assembly the children have decided that they would like to support the families and children who have lost everything in Indonesia. They have been trying to think of as many ways as possible to fundraise and have decided that they would like everyone to "fill a box for ShelterBox".

Fill a box for Shelterbox – fill a box with coins – any shape, any size and return to school after half-term.



Ideally they would like to raise enough money to cover the cost of a ShelterBox which is £600.

We are sure you will all have seen the recent news concerning the recent earthquake in Indonesia and the devastation that this has caused the country. Blocked roads, a damaged airport and broken telecommunications are making it difficult to get help to those in affected areas.
